What is Soap Hockey?

Soap hockey is played on large, heavy duty tarp that is covered in a secret blend of soap (we're taking that to our grave).

- Teams consist of 6 players and it's a 3 on 3 format.
- There are no slap shots, no body checking and of course, no fighting.
- Instead of skates, you play in bare feet. (*Pedicure anyone?*)

What equipment do I need?

Basically nothing except clothing (*that's important...seriously*).

- Instead of skates, you play in bare feet.
- We supply the sticks which are a version of floor hockey sticks and instead of a puck; we use a light weight ball.
- Helmets are mandatory.

What Divisions are available?

We will be offering four divisions which will consist of two men's and two women's. While there are two "competitive" divisions, Players must be a minimum 19 years of age to play.

Men's Open Division: Competitive division

Men's Rec Division: Competitive but with a bit more emphasis on fun

Women's Open Division: Competitive division

Women's Rec Division: The ladies play hard and may party harder

What else is happening that weekend?

Lots of stuff will be happening...it's the summertime in cottage country.

- We will also have live entertainment in the afternoon and evening on Friday and Saturday.
